The Truck:

- ✓ Flashlight (Extra Batteries)
- ✓ Emergency Numbers such as:
 - *Your veterinarian
 - *Physician
 - *Emergency Contact
- ✓ Insurance Card
- ✓ Jumper Cables
- ✓ Tool Box (Commonly used items such as wrenches, screwdriver, sockets, lug wrench)
- ✓ Phone Charger
- ✓ Cell Phone
- ✓ Fire Extinguisher
- ✓ First Aid Kit (Human)
- ✓ Tire Chains
- ✓ Extra Oil, Antifreeze, Brake Fluid, Transmission fluid
- ✓ Bottled Water
- ✓ Blankets
- ✓ Food/snacks
- ✓ Road Map (there isn't cell service everywhere)
- ✓ Spare Tire (check air before you go)
- ✓ Jack (Make sure everything is in working order)
- ✓ Air pump, portable compressor or air tank
- ✓ Tire gauge
- ✓ Check your hitch!
- ✓ Extra cotter pin for hitch coupler
- ✓ Extra Hitch Pin
- ✓ Knife

- ✓ Flashlight (Extra Batteries)

- ✓ First Aid Kit (Equine)
- ✓ Registration papers & Coggins for horses
- ✓ Tire Chains for Trailer
- ✓ Water for Horses
- ✓ Horse Blanket
- ✓ Hay, Grain, Supplements
- ✓ Spare Tire (check air before you go)
- ✓ Jack or [Trailer Aid](#)
- ✓ Emergency Flares or Safety Triangles
- ✓ Bug Spray (For warm weather trips)
- ✓ Leg wraps
- ✓ Soft ride boots for sore footed horses
- ✓ Hoofboots for riding (if not shod)
- ✓ Fork, wheelbarrow (collapsible)
- ✓ Buckets, Rags, Sponge
- ✓ Extra Halter and Leadrope
- ✓ ID Tags on horse or halter
